- Promote the Colebridge's best practice guidance/code of conducts within the club.
- Ensure adherence to the Colebridge's safeguarding children training.
- Ensure appropriate confidentiality is maintained.
- → Promote anti-discriminatory practice.
- Take responsibility for personal conflicts of interest and declaring, recording and managing these appropriately.
- Arranging handover or succession planning for the position.
