## Ratio:

During coaching sessions at Colebridge; there will be a maximum of 12 players at any one time for the coach running the session (1:12). The average number of players attending sessions is approximately 8-10, therefore a ratio or 1:8 – 1:10. Table Tennis England advise a ratio of 1:12, however, up to 1:16 is within recommendations.
