### FINANCIAL REPORT

The decline in senior membership has significantly impacted our income. This decline is somewhat mitigated by reduced running costs and outgoings as the club has been closed for significant periods. With a new roof being urgently required the committee continue to look for ways to raise additional funds. Thank you to **Michael Rinnhofer** who has worked hard on the finances of the club throughout the year.

### SITE & DRIVE

As always, the condition of our site remains a concern. Thank you to the members who have ensured any maintenance and repair issues are addressed. **Roy Prosser** has organised the drains and gutters to be cleared, as well as electrical repairs.

Additionally, **Roy** organised EH Smith to donate two tonnes of hardcore to fill the potholes in the drive. Thank you to the following members who have supported in completing the driveway work, along with the cutting back of the trees and bushes in the site, **John Swinburne, Evelyn & Roy Prosser, Micky Welsh, Steve Ratheram, Robert Chapman** and **Barry James**.

The committee are working hard on the ongoing roof issues. This is a time consuming and complicated task, but one which the committee are treating as essential work. Whilst funds to replace the roof are being sought, there have been some repairs to the roof, to help reduce the leaks.

### DEVELOPMENT

**Kate Hughes** successfully applied to Sport England for a Return to Play grant of £4,100, which is being used to purchase some additional equipment for coaching, as well as to support the junior and adult coaching programmes with additional sessions during a week. The grant also included an allocation of funds for cleaning equipment to ensure Colebridge remains Covid secure.

**Neil Wheatley** made a successful application to the Baron Davenport Charity, and Colebridge received £1000 in early June. Thank you to Neil for his hard work and effort in making the application.

Additionally, Kate applied to Table Tennis England for a BeTT grant for £500 to aid the delivery of the TT Kidz programme, which is an 8-week programme, designed for under 11-year olds. Kate along with **Sophie Rinnhofer** hope this will commence in October in line with TTE guidance.
