Summary for Members

- 1: Following the successful delivery of the TT Kidz programme, Colebridge are going to offer the following session in 2022.
 - TT Kidz Skills Awards coaching session commencing Monday 10th January 2022 at 5.15-6.15pm. These sessions will be booked in 6-week blocks. Players must be a Colebridge Member to attend these sessions.
 - **TT Kidz Programme Phase 5** commencing Saturday 5th February 2022 at 1.15-2.15pm. This is an 8-week programme, players do not need to be Colebridge members, and spaces are booked via www.ttkidz.co.uk
- 2: Following the introduction of 'Plan B' in England, Table Tennis England have updated their advice and therefore the following applies to Colebridge:
 - **Face coverings** should be worn when not participating, coaching, or officiating in an activity/event.
 - Face coverings are not required when exercising, as it is not recommended to wear a face covering while exercising or strenuous activity.
 - You should limit close contact with other people.
 - You may choose to take a lateral flow test before being in close contact and encourage those people you are meeting with to do so.
 - You should continue to observe the sanitizing and cleaning procedures, also ventilation is very important, so please ensure you always have the fans on in both rooms.
- 3: **Freezing pipes**: A reminder to all key holders that when locking up you should turn off the water, flush all the toilets and empty any water from the taps.
