Warwickshire Schools Individual Table Tennis Championships 2023

The Warwickshire Schools Individual Table Tennis Championships took place on Sunday 29th January 2023 at Meon Vale Leisure Centre in Stratford. There were 61 competitors taking part across seven events.

Under 11 Girls:

Charlotte Wong (Widney Junior School) retained her Under 11 Girls title from 2022, beating **Poppy Hinton**, Stevie-Jayne Mason and Joanna Simpson in a round-robin competition. Poppy finished in runner-up position. This competition was the first tournament that Poppy, Stevie-Jayne and Joanna had taken part in following the completion of their TT Kidz programme, so a big well done to all the girls.

Under 11 Boys:

Nokulus Lam Chun Nok (Widney Junior School) won the under 11 boys competition, beating Leon Burdett in the semi-finals, and **Lee Chun Ming Rex** in the final 3-0. Rex beat Dean Tuan-Mu in the second semi-final 3-1. A total of eight boys took part in the under 11 boys event, several of whom were competing in their first table tennis competition.

Under 13 Girls:

The under 13 girls had a brilliant entry with six girls taking part. **Hazel Lam** won the round-robin competition winning all of her matches, including beating her older sister **Hailey Lam** into second place. Similar to the under 11 girls and boys events, five of the players were taking part in their first table tennis competition.

The under 13 boys final was a repeat of last years under 11 boys final, between Aarif Li and Rex Ho (both from Tudor Grange Academy). **Aarif Li** was once again the champion, beating **Rex Ho** in a five-set battle (11-3, 6-11, 11-7, 12-14, 11-6). Aarif had beaten Toby John 3-0 in the semi-finals, whereas Rex had beaten Ollie Endersby in the second semi-finals.

Under 16 Girls:

Esther Lam (Myton School) beat Man Nga Chan Mia (King's High School) in the final 3-0, having beaten Anya Sompura (Rugby High School) in the semi-finals. Mia had beaten Susie Swan (Myton School) in the second semi-finals. Once again it was great to see eight girls participating in the under 16 girls competition.

Under 16 Boys:

There was an exceptionally strong field of 15 players in the under 16 boys event, who competed in three groups of five players, with the top two players progressing to the knock out stages, and several five-set matches determined who progressed. Starry Sheung (Warwick School), won group one, with Yin Ching Ng (Jaymas) (Tudor Grange Academy) finishing in second place, just ahead of Hong Kit Ng (Harold). In group 2, **Rex Wong** (Warwick School) finished in first place, with Jun Chung (Alcester Academy) second, and Alex Setchell third. In group 3, Daniel Stone (North Leamington School) finished in top position, having beaten Angus Li (Tudor Grange Academy) and Hong Wing Ng (Bertie) in five-sets who finished second and third respectively.

In the quarter finals, Daniel beat Jaymas 3-2, whilst Angus beat Jun 3-1. In the semifinals Starry beat Angus 3-0, whilst Rex beat Daniel 3-0. The final was a close encounter between Starry and Rex, with **Starry Sheung** coming through 3-2 (9-11, 11-7, 8-11,11-9, 11-7).

Under 19 Girls:

Hanne Pui Yu Chui was the only player who entered the under 19 girls competition, therefore she has received a direct entry to the National Schools Individual Finals.

Under 19 Boys:

A round-robin of four players took place for the under 19 boys. **Christopher Ho** (KES Stratford) finished in first place, ahead of **Sheung Yin Sean Lee** (Tudor Grange Academy). Jack Mobberley (also Tudor Grange) finished in third place, ahead of Michael Khovanov (also KES Stratford).
