## Warwickshire Schools Individual Table Tennis Championships 2024

The Warwickshire Schools Individual Table Tennis Championships took place on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> January 2024 at Meon Vale Leisure Centre in Stratford. There were 56 competitors taking part across all eight events.

#### **Under 11 Girls:**

**Dora Wong**, only eight years old, won the under 11 Girls title, winning a round robin event, beating both Ella Nwanoro and Jessica Barrow. Ella beat Jessica to finish in second place. For all three girls it was their first table tennis competition so well done!

#### **Under 11 Boys:**

**Nokulus Lam** retained his under 11 boys title from last year, beating Dean Tuan-Mu 3-1 in the final. In the two semi-finals, Nokulus had beaten Daiwik Sompura 3-0, whilst Dean beat Tommy Moyle by the same score line. It was great to see twelve under 11 boys competing this year, the highest number of competitors across any event, several of whom are still eligible to play in the same age category next season.

## **Under 13 Girls:**

**Charlotte Wong** won the round robin event, comprised of six competitors. There were some close matches between the players, including Charlotte's final match against Chuanyu Cheung, which she won 11-6, 8-11, 9-11, 11-7, 14-12. Cheung finished in second place, and Isla Turner (playing in this event for the first time, finished 3<sup>rd</sup>).

## **Under 19 Girls:**


