- ➔ Agree to and act upon Colebridge's Equity and Safeguarding policies; and Codes of Conduct.
- ➔ Produce the Colebridge Annual Report in preparation for the AGM.
- ➔ Taking responsibility for personal conflicts of interest and declaring, recording and managing these appropriately.
- ➔ Arranging handover or succession planning for the position.
